	You can find the names of colors in a lot of English expressions. Many of these expressions, however, talk about colors in very different ways. For example, the color red is often used to talk about things that are hot or exciting. You can listen to red-hot jazz music or eat red-hot chili peppers. If you roll out the red carpet for someone, you are giving them a big welcome. On TV, you may see stars walking on the red carpet at the opening night of a Hollywood movie or at the Academy Awards.
